Rasmus Janse had percussion stiff resistance in the oldest class, but he went unbeaten through the tournament and could win the sterile with the referral in the final round. It was the fourth Rasmus School SM title! It was close, we got a winner for. Emil Carmegren although he was undefeated, remiseraade against both number one and number two in his class and ended up on the same points as these, but had slightly lower quality score. Bronze medal was a receipt for the considerable progress that Emil has done during the year.

The D-class sprinted Daniel Vatn enter a PEACHY fourth place and had many deserving players behind him on the price list.
